I would like to gather information about the history of our chapter to display on our web site. Please contact me if you have any information or material to contribute. This chapter has been in existence for many years and we should document our history!

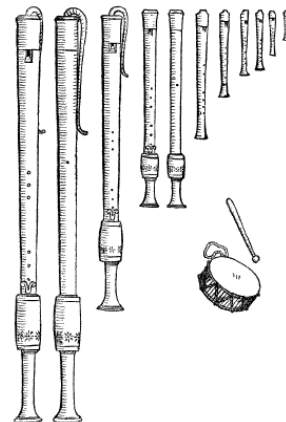
About the Conductor
